New Water Rates Effective from October

In order to continue to securely provide water, a large amount of money must be expended in order to upgrade current facilities. Due to the cost shortfall, water rates will be increased by 14% starting from this October, which will be reflected in December's meter reading and payment.

Rate Change Calculator

A rate conversion calculator is now available which allows you to input the amount of water used and find out the amount to be paid under the new rate.

Examples:

1. Water Used: 14m³ (Single household, 2 months' usage)

1,936円(Present rate) + 220円 = 2,156円(New rate)

2. Water Used: 28m³ (2-person household, 2 mo. usage)

3,212円 (Present rate) + 462円 = 3,674円(New rate)

*The amount of water used is for illustrative purposes only, and rates will vary depending on the actual amount of water used.

Rules for Bicycles and Motor Vehicles

The number of bicycle and motorized vehicles removed from the streets around train stations and other locations continues to increase. **A confiscation and custody fee must be paid to return the impounded vehicles.** Please ensure that you observe the rules for **parking your bicycle or motorized vehicle**, even if you park for just a brief while.

Rules for Bicycles and Motor Vehicles:

1. Use designated parking spaces
2. Do not park or stand your bicycle/motor vehicle on the sidewalk, even for a short amount of time
3. When parking on private property, ensure that your bicycle/vehicle does not come out onto the sidewalk



Confiscation and Custody Fee:

Bicycles: 2,500円

Motor vehicles: 5,000円

Kodomotto Children's Plaza: Center for Consultation, Recreation, and Exchange

Kodomotto Children's Plaza is a facility for children and their parents/guardians. First-time visiting families raising an infant (age 0) can receive a "Baby Steps" (*Hajimete Odekake*) care package.

Baby Steps Care Package:

Eligible Persons: Households with an infant (child age 0) from April 1, 2024 onwards

Receiving Period: Until the day before the child becomes one (1) years old

※Children born in April or May 2023 are still eligible until Friday, May 31 2024

Fee: Free

Application: N/A

Please bring the following:

1. Maternal and child health handbook (母子健康手帳)
2. Proof of Kobe City residence for child (MyNumber Card, Child Medical Expense Beneficiary Card, Residence Record, etc.)
