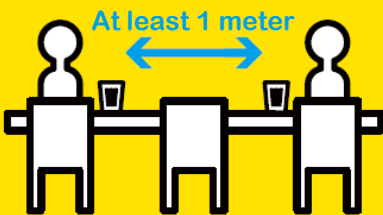

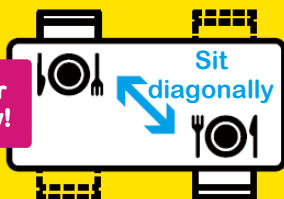

Vaccination Information

When can I get vaccinated?



From August 31, **everyone aged 12 years or over** can schedule their vaccination appointment. 12 to 15-year-olds were mailed their vaccination vouchers on August 30. (11-year-olds will receive their vouchers the month following their 12th birthday.)

We recommend 12 to 15-year-olds to schedule their vaccinations with their primary care physician. In principle, they must be accompanied by their parent or guardian. (Please schedule by phone.)

Hospitalization Fees Free for High School Students!

Kobe City subsidizes most out-of-pocket hospital costs under the Children's Medical Fees Subsidy system. And from October, hospitalization (inpatient) fees for high school students will also be free.

Renovation of Kobe Port Tower

Port Tower will be closed long-term after Sunday, September 26 for renovations.

The popular landmark is scheduled to reopen in 2023, which is the tower's 60th anniversary. You will be able to go up to the roof, which will feature an observation promenade with a 360° view of the Kobe waterfront. There will also be a terrace on the 4th floor with a view of the Port of Kobe.
